- "He who belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God" (John 8:47).
- 1. In the Old Testament God spoke in many ways. That God spoke is the most important factor, not how He spoke.
 - a. When God spoke, it was usually unique to that individual.
 - b. When God spoke, the person was sure God was speaking.
 - c. When God spoke, the person knew what God said.
 - d. When God spoke, that was the encounter with God.


