**HYMN OF THE DAY:** Our hymn of the day is *Crown Him with Many Crowns*. In the Gospel reading, the crowds shout, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the king of Israel." Though the crowds acclaimed Jesus as their king, they didn't fully know what that meant. We do, because we have seen Jesus' crucifixion. So we crown him with many crowns, the crown of love, because he showed his love to us on the cross. The crown of life, because he triumphed over the grave. The crown of heaven, because he is enthroned in worlds above. We crown him king of kings and lord of lords because he is king of all.

**A WORD:** Our Old Testament reading highlights God's power to kill and make alive. He alone is God, and he alone can do such wonders. He will prove his power in his Son, who is killed on Good Friday and raised on Easter Sunday. The Gospel reading shows us the enthusiasm with which the crowds greeted Jesus on Palm Sunday. They were looking for a political king, but Jesus is a king whose kingdom is not of this world. His kingdom means freedom from death, sin, hell, and life in God's presence eternally.

The epistle reading shows us how Jesus became our Lord. Not by asserting his power as a tyrant, but by giving up his power out of love. He became our servant by taking on the form of man. He was obedient to the Father for our salvation, and because of his great work of salvation, God has raised our savior to the highest place and crowned him king of kings and lord of lords.

BIBLE READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY: Isaiah 65:17-25 1Corinthians 15:1--26 Luke 24:1-12

This is the time of the church year where we focus on Christ's death for our sin (Maundy Thursday and Good Friday) and celebrate his resurrection for our salvation (Easter Sunday). **ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER:** On Passion Sunday, we are soon reminded that the image of palm branches in hand will be replaced with hammer and nails. We see here what our sin has done to our Lord. So, on this day that combines celebration and crucifixion, we see in our Lord the King and Savior with blessing in His hands.
