DAY 4 Read Luke 19:8 focusing on Zacchaeus' Statement of Faith.

What's so incredible about Zacchaeus' statement here? How do you think this is connected to his faith in Jesus? What does Zacchaeus mean by saying, "And IF I have cheated people on their taxes...?" What does your personal commitment to Jesus look like on a practical level? Pray 1John 3:16-18.

DAY 5 Read Luke 19:9-10 focusing on Jesus' Response to Zacchaeus.

Is Jesus saying Zacchaeus is saved by giving all that money or what else does He mean? Can you back that up by Scripture? What does Jesus mean about being a true son of Abraham? Connect this with James 2:19-24. What's the bottom line of Jesus' Mission according to vs.10 and how are you involved in this? Pray for a heart that seeks Jesus and the lost.

"Going Out on a Limb to Find & Follow Jesus"

(Jesus & Zacchaeus)

Luke 19:1-10

"Then he said to the crowd, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross daily, and follow me." Luke 9:23 NLT

1. Seek Jesus with Intensity.

"Jesus entered Jericho and made his way through the town. There was a man there named Zacchaeus. He was the chief tax collector in the region, and he had become very rich. He tried to get a look at Jesus, but he was too short to see over the crowd. So, he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree beside the road, for Jesus was going to pass that way."

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me."

2. Say Yes to Jesus' Invitation.

"When Jesus came by, he looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name. "Zacchaeus!" he said. "Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today." Zacchaeus quickly climbed down and took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy. But the people were displeased. "He has gone to be the guest of a notorious sinner," they grumbled."

3. Show Your Faith with Integrity that makes an Impact.

"Meanwhile, Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, "I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!" Jesus responded, "Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost."

What do you think it was that caused Jesus to look at Zacchaeus and call him by name? If you were Zacchaeus here, what would you be thinking? What does it mean to you that Jesus said He "must" come to Zac's house – why? How comfortable are you with Jesus knowing everything about you and still wanting to "be at home" with you? Explain. Pray with Jesus.

DAY 3 Read Luke 19:6-7 focusing on Zacchaeus' Response to Jesus. How would you describe Zacchaeus' attitude about Jesus coming over? How is this different from the people in the crowd and why? What does it look like for you to spend time with Jesus and how would you rate your level of excitement & joy about it? Forget about everything & everyone else and spend time alone with Jesus.
