And the day of vengeance of our God;

To comfort all that mourn;

3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion,

To give unto them beauty for ashes,

The oil of joy for mourning,

The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;

## Context

Isaiah 59:19-20

19 So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west,

And his glory from the rising of the sun.

When the enemy shall come in like a flood,

The Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.

20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion,

And unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the Lord.

### The Intent of God from the Beginning

Reverence

 (Isaiah 59:19 So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, And his glory from the rising of the sun.)

### Resiliency

 (Isaiah 59:19 So When the enemy shall come in like a flood, The Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.)

# Redemption

- o (*Isaiah 59:20* So And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, And unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the Lord.)
- Transgress: to violate a boundary or law. (Webster's Dictionary)

- Choosing
  - o (The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; Because the Lord hath anointed me to preach)

# Communicating

- (good tidings unto the meek;)
- Meek: Enduring injury with patience without resentment; deficient in spirit or courage, not violent or strong. (Webster's Dictionary)

Isaiah 41:27-28

27 The first shall say to Zion, Behold, behold them: And I will give to Jerusalem one that bringeth good tidings.

28 For I beheld, and there was no man; Even among them, and there was no counselor, That, when I asked of them, could answer a word.

29 Behold, they are all vanity; their works are nothing: Their molten images are wind and confusion

#### Caring

 (He hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to them that are bound;)

*Isaiah 61:2* To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all that mourn;

# **The Comforting Word of God**

- Declaring
  - o (Isaiah 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord,)
  - The year of God's favor jubilee

Leviticus 25:10

And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubile unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family.

- War
  - (And the day of vengeance of our God;)
- Peace
  - (To comfort all that mourn)

Isaiah 40:1-3

1 Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God.

2 Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her,

That her warfare is accomplished,

That her iniquity is pardoned:

For she hath received of the Lord's hand double for all her sins

3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion,

To give unto them beauty for ashes,

The oil of joy for mourning,

The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;

That they might be called trees of righteousness

The planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified.

# One of the Principal Purposes of God Word to Reclaimed the Rejected

- Reserving
  - (To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion,)
- Replacing
  - o To give unto them beauty for ashes,
  - The oil of joy for mourning,
  - The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;
- Rescuing
  - (That they might be called trees of righteousness,)

Isaiah 60:21-22

21 Thy people also shall be all righteous:

They shall inherit the land for ever,

The branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.

22 A little one shall become a thousand,

And a small one a strong nation:

I the Lord will hasten it in his time.

- Reclamation
  - o (The planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified.)
  - Reclamation
    - the act or process of reclaiming: such as
    - REFORMATION, REHABILITATION

- restoration to use : RECOVERY
- o REFORMATION to form again
- REHABILITATION
  - to restore to a former capacity : REINSTATE
  - to restore to good repute :
  - to restore to a former state (as of efficiency, good management, or solvency)
  - to restore or bring to a condition of health or useful and constructive activity
  - Synonyms: cure, fix, heal, mend, rehab, set up
- o **RECOVERY** 
  - to cover again or anew
  - the process of combating a disorder or a real or perceived problem
  - Synonyms: comeback, convalescence, healing, mending, rally, recuperation, rehab, rehabilitation, snapback
