Leaders to fulfill their

- Intent: Develop current and future spiritual leaders to fulfill their ministry (Leadership Team, Deacons, Ministry Teams)
- How Action Plan:
 - Assess and train ministry leaders to fulfill their ministry
 - Assess and revise the leadership structure to be more effective and to align with Scripture
 - Establish charters and annual action plans for each ministry
 - Offer a ministry fair to share opportunities for members to serve in ministry roles of the church
 - Seek to raise up new leaders in the church (Leadership Team, Deacons, established and new ministries, possibly Elders)

 - Establish operational budget on undesignated giving

 - Establish a long range, lifecycle facilities sustainment plan
