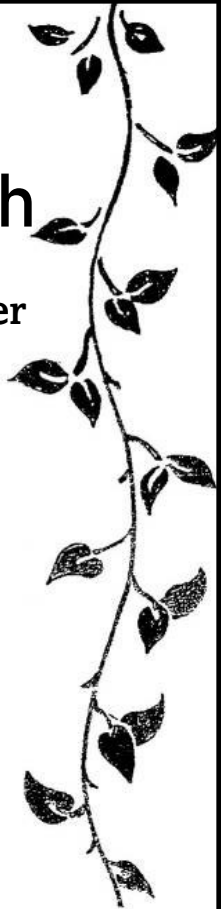
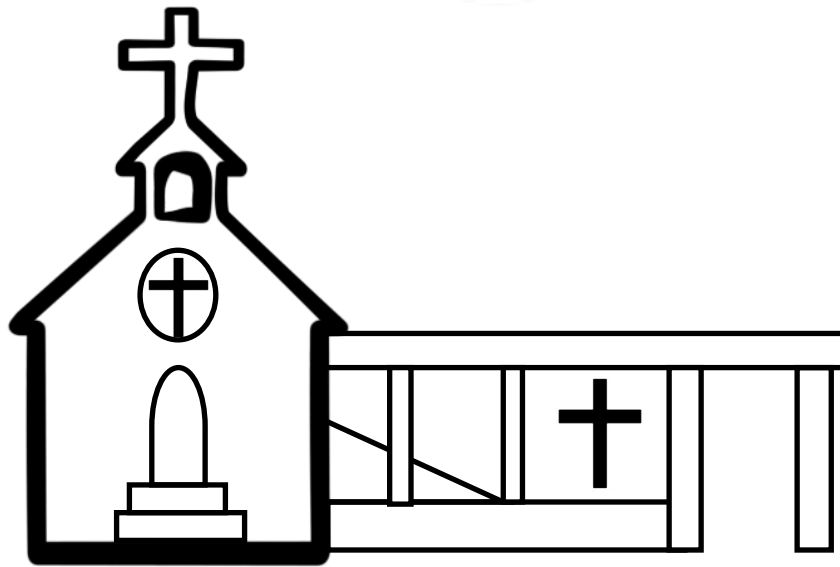

Whether or not we know their names or where they live, they are our neighbors, our brothers, and sisters in Christ. We pray all this in the name of Jesus, the One who is our hope.
