One of the Principal Purposes of God's Word to Reclaim the Rejected

- Reserving room for the rejected.
 - o (To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion,)
- Replacing
 - To give unto them beauty for ashes,
 - The oil of joy for mourning,
 - The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;
- Rescuing

- (That they might be called trees of righteousness,)
- o Trees" (Hebrew, eeleey, terebinth trees); symbolical of men strong in righteousness, instead of being, as heretofore, bowed down as a reed with sin and calamity.

Isaiah 60:21-22

21 Thy people also shall be all righteous:

They shall inherit the land for ever,

The branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.

22 A little one shall become a thousand,

And a small one a strong nation:

I the Lord will hasten it in his time.

- Reclamation
 - o (The planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified.)
 - o Reclamation
 - the act or process of reclaiming: such as
 - REFORMATION, REHABILITATION
 - restoration to use : RECOVERY
 - o REFORMATION to form again
 - REHABILITATION
 - to restore to a former capacity : REINSTATE
 - to restore to good repute :
 - to restore to a former state (as of efficiency, good management, or solvency)
 - to restore or bring to a condition of health or useful and constructive activity
 - Synonyms: cure, fix, heal, mend, rehab, set up
 - RECOVERY
 - to cover again or anew
 - the process of combating a disorder or a real or perceived problem
 - Synonyms: comeback, convalescence, healing, mending, rally, recuperation, rehab, rehabilitation, snapback
