DB's Dabblings: "Education Plans—Sunday Mornings—3 Big Questions"

In dealing with the challenges of life we seem to continue to be faced 3 Big Questions:

Who am I? – Identity

How do I fit in? - Belonging

What should I do? - Purpose

We face these **3 Big Questions** in all stages of our lives. It starts early and we never outgrow them. It is important as a Church Family to hear every generation work through them and support one another in the process. To help us do this, I will preach a series on these **3 Big Questions**, and we will deal with them in our Adult and Youth Ministry Summer Bible Classes.

There will be 3 Classes in 3 Locations (Auditorium, Room 109, Family Center) dealing with these 3 Big Questions. There will be a class coordinator in each of the three classes. The students will be randomly placed in the 3 Classes by "drawing lots" to promote intergenerational discussions. We will have 3 classes on each of the 3 Big Questions. These 9 Classes will be scheduled in June, July (not July 3), Aug. 7 taught by various teachers. The Teens will have their own classes with some selected adults involved in each class discussion of the 3 Big Questions to pull in an intergenerational perspective. We will break the teens into two groups, Sr H and Jr H; and we will also have a "Bridge Class" (grades 5-6) all studying the 3 Big Questions. The college students will be integrated into the adult classes and/or be used in helping teach the teens' and children's classes. We will have combined adult classes May 22 and May 29 to divide into classes and introduce the materials. We will also have a special combined class for July 3 and in conclusion of the series August 14.




