HYMN OF THE DAY: Our hymn of the day is *Now All the Vault of Heaven Resounds*. The vault of heaven resounds with the praise of Christ, the lamb who was slain, "Christ has triumphed! He is living!" We listen to that hymn of praise in the reading from Revelation, where Christ takes the scroll from the right hand of the Father. Because he has conquered God's enemies through his death and resurrection, ransoming a people for God from every tribe, tongue, and nation, Christ is worthy to receive all praise, all glory, all honor, and all power. Even today, this victorious lamb rules all things for the good of God's people and the glory of his Father.

A WORD: The reading from Revelation presents Christ to us as the one who rules and directs all things. We see an example of Christ's rule and direction in the conversion of St. Paul. Christ had a plan for Paul, and at just the right time, he reveals himself to this murderer of his people and commissions him as the greatest evangelist the church has ever seen. Jesus does the same for Peter, commanding him to feed his sheep. Christ is the one in control. Even when the forces of sin and evil appear to have the upper-hand, Christ is in control, ruling and directing, just as he did for Peter and Paul.
