Fourth 'Good Shepherd' Sunday of Easter - 8th May 2022

I ask you this week to pray for vocations: that from our parish and for our diocese young men and women will hear God's call to dedicate themselves to the care of his flock. Jesus himself tells us to ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest.

You will see that this invitation is for young men and young women to hear and answer God's call. It is not perhaps yet clear what *new* pathways will open up in the church for young women and young men to express that share in caring for the Lord's flock, but it will be in particular the lay women and lay men of this generation who will carve them out as the Holy Spirit moves in their lives and in the life of the church. They will be the brave and resilient people, the saints, whom the Lord will raise up in our day, giving new life to his church and hope to the world.

There is also a need to pray for vocations to the ministerial priesthood. When we reflected over the winter on what was important in our parish, I was quite humbled by the number who mentioned the priest as part of that. I think it reflects our need for the Eucharist and our need for outward and visible signs of Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd.

It is difficult to be unaware that many people find the requirement of priestly celibacy and the ordination only of men to be difficult in the twenty-first century, or to be unaware that people have sometimes been harmed by the ministers of the Church, or that some priests have been unhappy in their ministry. When we have mixed feelings about things it can be difficult to pray for them. And since God makes us sharers in his goodness towards us by asking us to pray for what we need, why would he impose on us something we do not ask for or want?

For myself, I have to say that I am grateful to my parents, and the priests, sisters and people of my home parish and beyond who prayed for vocations to the priesthood, and sometimes specifically for mine. Without their prayers (and yours) I would not be a priest today, and I do not think I would be as fulfilled – and as fully myself – if I were not. We need to pray for the young people of our parish: that they will come to know the Lord, hear his call and answer generously.

The hope of the world depends on it, and they will be all the happier for it.
