Westminster Shorter Catechism #92: *What is a sacrament?* A sacrament is a holy regulation established by Christ, in which Christ and the benefits of the new covenant are represented, sealed, and applied to believers by physical signs.

This morning we welcome Pastor Billy Dempsey to the Westminster Pulpit. Pastor Dempsey was born and reared in Byhalia, MS.
