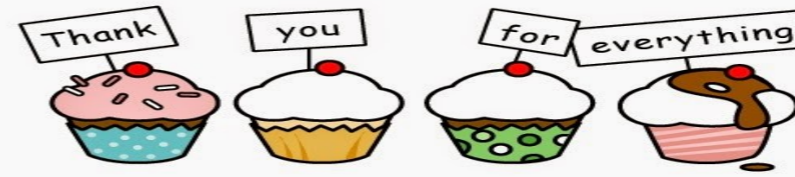

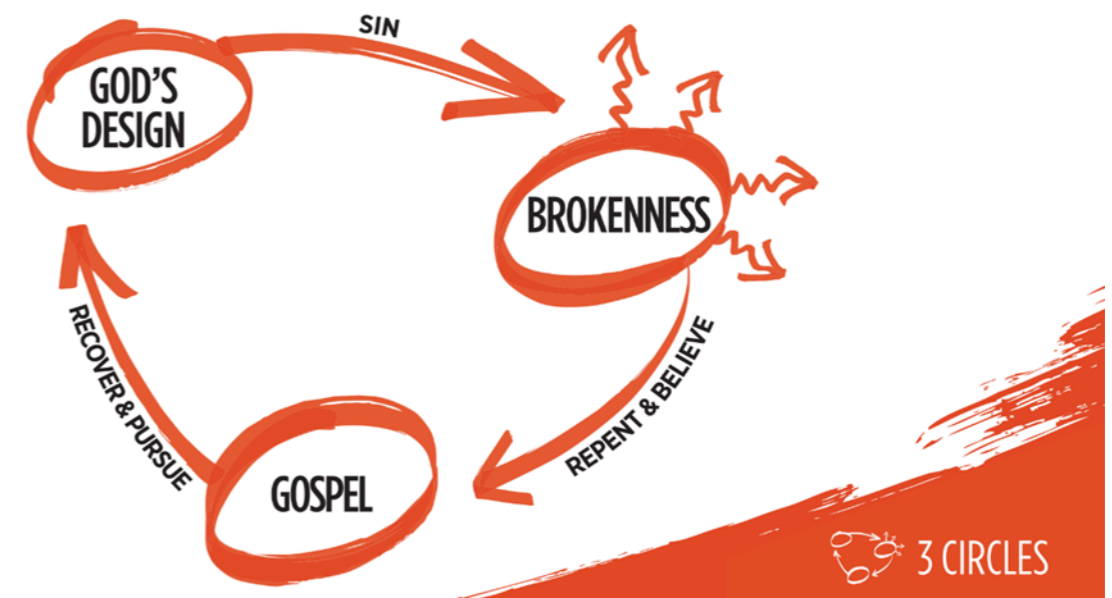


FAITH LIFE
