



FBC Harrison Worship Ministry Expectations

Purpose: To worship the one true living God. To be more committed to being a worshiper than part of the worship teams. *Psalms 73:25-26 "Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on the earth that I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever."*

Expectations:

1. A lifestyle that is continually growing to conform to the image of Christ.

- Be a good testimony to the body (the church family). Cheerful, considerate, not boastful.
- Cooperative spirit within the worship ministry. A desire to care more about the team and the goal than one's self.
- Strive to have daily worship time in prayer and study of the Word.

2. Faithful attendance:

- We don't have very much time for rehearsals each week for such important work. For this reason, all rehearsals are required.
 - Please arrive early enough to be ready to start on the downbeat (beginning of rehearsal)
 - For instrumentalists, having all your gear ready by downbeat
 - For vocalists, having all your electronics ready and on by downbeat
 - For tech teams, making sure you're there early enough to get any equipment on and ready for downbeat.
- Attend regular church services regularly whether you're working in the worship ministry or not. It is important for our hearts, and also for other people to see the leaders of the church being a part of the body.

3. Consistent Communication.

- Promptly and faithfully respond to Planning Center emails.
- Block out dates when unavailable.
- In the case of an unexpected change where you must cancel, call or text Chris ASAP (281) 686-9624.

4. Dress to promote modesty and honor of the God we praise.

- Nothing Short, Nothing Tight, Nothing Low - We love fabric.
 - Ladies: Make Skirts/Dresses past knee length, no tank tops or "small straps"
 - Men: Pants only - jeans, slacks, "nice" pants.
- Inappropriate dress will result in a request to change clothes.
- If that is not possible, you may be asked to not lead for that service or event.
- If you doubt your choice in clothing, it is probably not okay.

- Our focal point, where we want people to aim their attention, is God's glory. I know that mission is in all our hearts. We don't want anything to get in the way of that mission.

5. Make time to prepare music and familiarize yourself with service details outside rehearsals.
