## **Small Group Questions**

#### 1. Getting Started:

- What did you find most interesting about the sermon this week? The most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
- What are your coordinates? (People, Place, Presence, Purpose)?

### 2. Into the Bible (1 Peter 3:8-22)

- How would you summarize the point of v. 8-12? What is Peter's instruction? What is the promise of the Psalm he quotes?
- People often read 1 Peter 3:15 out of context. What is Peter's overall focus in v. 13-17? How does v. 15 fit in?

How does suffering for good follow the example of Christ?
 What about when we do evil? What if we did the evil for the sake of good?

• V. 18-22 can be tough to interpret, but the link with the earlier verses is the phrase "clear conscience." What is the importance of a clear conscience in this passage?

### 3. Going Deeper

- Have you ever heard or seen people use the first part of 1 Peter 3:15 ("Always be prepared to give an answer") in ways that conflict with the end ("Do this with gentleness and respect")? How so?
- God's plan to get Paul to Rome involved having him arrested and imprisoned. Have you ever seen God use a hard—or unexpected—situation to give you an opportunity to serve him?
- God sent Paul to prison so he could witness to soldiers and slaves in Rome. Where has God sent you? How can you witness there?
