Officer Candidate Recommendation

The Session of Hope is excited to announce that we are **recommending Bradley Fullbright to the congregation of Hope for the office of Ruling Elder!** Over the past few months, Bradley has participated in the officer training course, completed a written Biblical/theological exam, and been examined/interviewed by the Session prior to making our recommendation. In addition, **we have called a Congregational Meeting for Sunday, June 19th immediately after the service** for the purpose of voting on whether or not to elect Bradley as a Ruling Elder. The BCO explains how there must be a period of at least 30 days between when officer candidates are presented to the congregation and when they are then voted on by the congregation. The purpose of this in part is to allow adequate time for people to ask questions of or voice any concerns they have to the Session about Bradley's candidacy.
