Primary Voting Info

Yes, it's time to vote again.

Early voting for the New Mexico Primary Election for upcoming races for governor, secretary of state, lieutenant governor and among others, the state's three federal Congressional Districts has begun. Primary Election Day is **June 7**th.

Please register and verify your information. Links to all information regarding registration, absentee ballot requests, voting by mail, candidates, issues, and sample ballots can be found at your county clerk's website.

Important Deadlines for the 2022 Primary Election:

- The online absentee portal for the 2022 Primary Election is now available to request an absentee ballot.
- May 10: Voter registration (by mail or online) closes.

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters (who have submitted an absentee application), and first day of Early Voting (at the county clerk's office) begins.

Early voting begins at the County Clerk's office

- May 21: Expanded Early Voting begins at alternate voting locations.
 Please check locations and hours of operation by visiting <u>NMVote.org</u> or by contacting your County Clerk's Office.
- **June 2**: Last day to request an absentee ballot.
- June 4: Last day of early voting.
- June 7: Primary Election Day. 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Absentee Ballots must be received in the clerk's office no later than 7 p.m.

Participation in primary elections is typically low. Please educate yourself and participate.

Exercising your right to vote is essential.



Homewise is announcing several community programs for homeowners and those who desire to become homeowners or good stewards of their finances:

- 1. Seniors and disabled homeowners can save on property taxes through the Value Freeze Program. Seniors (65+) and disabled homeowners with an annual income of \$37,300 or less can keep property taxes from rising year to year. Applications are being accepted statewide through April 30, 2022. If you live in Santa Fe or Bernalillo County, Homewise can help you prepare your application or provide general information to residents of other counties.
- 2. Are you a homeowner in Rio Rancho? The city of Rio Rancho and Homewise have joined together in a pilot program for home renovation. Affordable deferred loans of up to \$25,000 are available to those who qualify with 80% of the Average Median Income. Loans are forgivable after 5 years as long as the homeowner remains in the property.
- 3. Are you interested in improving your credit or financial fitness? Are you renting now and desire to be a homeowner to be in your future? Homewise has in-person and virtual educational training on these topics to enhance financial freedom and homeownership as wealth building strategy.
