# Sermon Notes

## “God's Chosen People”

1 Peter 2:9-10

Pastor Mauricio Castro

<sup>9</sup> But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. <sup>10</sup> Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy (1 Peter 2:9-10 NIV).

In this passage God teaches us four important facts that happened through the death of Jesus on the cross:

This new status becomes a reality in the life of every human being when we accept Jesus Christ in our hearts with a single purpose.

As a church today, we need to remember every day to live as the **Chosen People** of God so that the Glory of our God and Father may be known by future generations.

In love <sup>5</sup> he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will ((Ephesians 1:3-5 NIV).




## New AWARE Food Bank Partnership Explained

We are excited to announce a short-term partnership with the AWARE Food Bank as they begin to use our east wing as their TEMPORARY food distribution center this next week. Their building was destroyed by fire last August and recently needed to move to another temporary location while their current building is rebuilt. They are using most of the east wing of our building, which now has a separate entrance and the doors into the rest of the church are securely locked.

As part of their usage agreement, they will give our church \$4,000/month (plus utilities). All modifications (a new sidewalk in the back plus electrical upgrades) are being done at the expense of the food bank. They will be in our facility for at least the next 12 months.

They distribute food four days a week: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9:00AM to 12:00PM. They also distribute food two afternoons a month.
