

Community Church of PK Emergency Members Meeting
May 22, 2022

The Special May Business Meeting was called to order by Council Member Terry Reynolds at 12:17 pm on Sunday, May 22, 2022. There were 30 members present.

This emergency meeting was called to provide the church body with a request from Pastor Jack Thomas. Due to increased gas prices continuing to climb, and having late night turn arounds at the church, Pastor Jack is requesting to move an RV that he is buying from the Zanni family onto the property and putting where the temporary office trailer was during church construction.

Kevin proposed instead of him moving an RV in, to adding a gas reimbursement instead so Jack can still be at home, but that if it was decided on the RV that we may have to check with the BRA first on what we are allowed to do regarding septic, etc.

Jack spoke and said that as an example, Saturday night they were at the church late, and had to turn around and come back the next morning early and that with Summer approaching and the anticipation of late nights with Vacation Bible School, etc. They would prefer to stay here so that their family can be all together since Amy and the boys will be out from school so they can have that time together as well and that they knew there would be gas usage when they accepted the position, it is more about their family being together then the gas situation.

After group discussion it was agreed that everyone is ok with Jack moving an RV onto the property and Kevin volunteered to help Jack with this moving forward.

Pastor Terry dismissed with prayer at 12:26 pm.
