Westminster Shorter Catechism #96: *What is the Lord's Supper?*

The Lord's Supper is a sacrament in which bread and wine are given and received as Christ directed to proclaim His death. Those who received the Lord's Supper in the right way share in His body and blood with all His benefits, not physically but by faith, and become spiritually stronger and grow in grace.

This morning we welcome Dr. Robert Hays to the Westminster Pulpit. Dr. Hays was raised in Forest and graduated from Belhaven in 1967. He served as a Navy Hospital Corpsman attached to the Marines (infantry) in Viet Nam. He received his M.Div. and his D.Min. from RTS. He is now retired and lives in Pearl. He met his wife Martha at Belhaven. Dr. Hays was ordained in the PCA in 1977 and has served churches in AR, OK, and MS. They have 2 children, 4 grandchildren and 5 step-grandchildren, and 4 great step-grandchildren.

We welcome Mr. John Yelverton to the Westminster Pulpit this evening. Mr. Yelverton is from Vaiden, Mississippi and a graduate of Mississippi State University. He has been married for sixteen years to his wife, Mariana, and they have two children: Clark and Robin.

Children who have not publicly confessed Christ by being received by the Session into communicant Church membership should refrain from the Sacrament and learn by reverent observation; this, even though they may already have received Christ privately. Those without personal saving faith in Jesus Christ are to refrain from the Sacrament and are urged to repent and receive Him by faith.

There will be a painting workday this Saturday, June 11, to paint the pastor study, the 2nd floor bathroom, and the old outdoor sign. We will start at 9:00 AM. Your help is needed.
