LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 16:1, 6, 7 The Lord said to Samuel, "How long will you mourn for Saul, since I have rejected him as king over Israel? Fill your horn with oil and be on your way; I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem. I have chosen one of his sons to be king." 6 When they arrived, Samuel saw Eliab and thought, "Surely the Lord's anointed stands here before the Lord." 7 But the Lord said to Samuel, "**Do not consider his appearance** or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."

LESSONS FOR US:

- Do not consider a person's appearance.
 - Something about Eliab's appearance and height convinced Samuel that he must be the Lord's anointed. But he was wrong. 1 Samuel 16:7
 - If we show special attention to a visitor to our assembly who wears fine clothes and ignore the poor looking visitor, we have discriminated and become judges with evil thoughts. James 2:1-4
 - Jesus said in John 7:24 "Do not judge by mere appearances, but instead judge correctly."
 - One way we can know a person's heart, is by their fruits, their actions. Jesus said in Matthew 7:20 "by their fruits you will know them."
