## **18 YEAR OLD STUDENTS ONLY**

All students who will be at least 18 years of age by the last day of Falls Creek of July 30 are required to do a **BACKGROUND CHECK**. These students need to register by July 17, so we will have time to process the background check.

## SPONSORS & CONTACT INFO **m**

Students will be led and cared for by trusted adult sponsors from our church throughout the week of camp. It is a mandatory policy for Falls Creek and our church to perform a background check on every person attending Falls Creek of 18 years of age and older, including adults and students.

## **CHECK-IN & LEAVE TIMES**



Please arrive with all luggage at the Marietta First Youth Room at 10:00am on Monday, July 25. An adult must be present with the student to check in. We leave 11:00am. Please eat before arrival or bring lunch.

### DRESS CODE 😔

- · Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin. · Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol,
- controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.
- · Under garments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. No boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- · No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- No tank tops.
- · No short shorts. At a minimum, shorts must extend to, or just beyond, the campers' finger tips.
- · No tight fitting and revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as
- · Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee.

#### SWIMMING:

- Girls should wear modest one-piece swim suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swimming suits.
- · While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes. Males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimming suits.

## CELL PHONES/MOBILE DEVICES



Students will be allowed to use their cell phones during the free time each day from 1:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. The phones can be used in the cabin's main downstairs gathering room and outside. Students are to turn off and turn in their cell phones each evening at dinner time. Their phones will be returned to them each day at lunch. One designated adult leader will be responsible for the phones that will be kept in a locked room. A checklist of each student and phone will be made by this adult for phone check in each evening. Please remember to turn off your phones before handing them in. With the exception of an emergency, students are NOT allowed to use cell phones any other time. If any student is caught with his or her cell phone outside of this designated free time, the phone will be taken. All phones that are taken will NOT be returned until the Saturday we leave.
