Dear Friends,

We're all aware that 2022 marks the 150th anniversary (the sesquicentennial) of the village of New Market, but it's also worth noting that this year also marks the sesquicentennial of our church. You might have seen the old church sign which has "1873" carved on it, and you might assume the church is a year younger than the town. But that's not exactly true. Our church *building* was completed in 1873 (well, the core of it – our sanctuary), but the congregation was already meeting, and was officially organized, the year before.

The valuable centennial booklet which was published fifty years ago to mark the 100th anniversary of our church notes that, "In the spring of 1872 the New Market Methodist Episcopal Church was organized from some of the local citizens and the remaining members of the Old Finley Chapel Church, located three and one-half miles northeast of here." The new congregation was then officially recognized by the "Quarterly Conference of the Ladoga Circuit," on August 31, 1872.

The congregation met "in a small building on West Main Street where Robert Servies resides," but decided a true church building was needed. Our plot of land was donated by "Joseph White, a circuit rider, and his wife Lucinda." Ground was broken on the new church building in September, and it was completed in August 1873.

The church building has undergone several changes over this century and a half. There was an extensive remodeling of the sanctuary in 1899; the Fellowship Hall and classrooms were added in 1962/1963; and the sanctuary was remodeled again in 1971 (and brought to its current state in 2012). And of course many of our members remember the complete overhaul of the basement, a Herculean task undertaken a decade and a half ago.

Over 60 pastors have served the congregation throughout the years. Many of our early pastors served only for a year or two at most, in a time when Methodist pastors were moved with great regularity. I have been proud to be among the many pastors to have served this church, and especially honored to have served for 11 years now, tying the tenure of Rev. Dale Payne, the other longest-serving pastor at New Market.

As we worship and study and fellowship together, we all need to pause at times, look around, and consider the generations of believers who have made New Market UMC the focal point of their Christian walk. We stand on the shoulders of thousands of others, going back 15 decades, who have literally built this beautiful church for us, and for the glory of God. Let's be grateful for all that they have done.

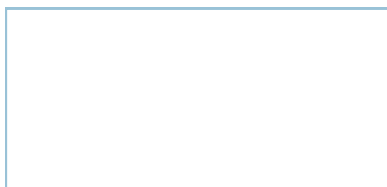

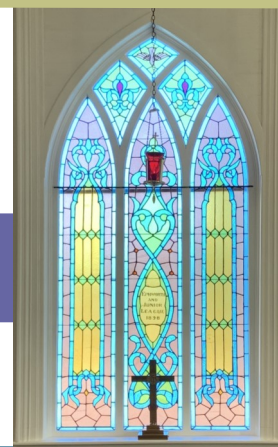
