Mission Memo ... Pray for Church Workers Around the World & in our Community

Rev. Michael and Irene Paul are missionaries in Taiwan. Pastor Paul is a theological educator in Taiwan, serving with the China Evangelical Lutheran Church and China Lutheran Seminary. He is called to teach, write, and help plant and pastor Lutheran churches. (The Big Event in 2018 helped to support him.) One of Rev. Paul's members, Jiayu, has taught 37 years in the public school. She invited a 4th grader, Yuyu, to come to Church and Sunday School. Yuyu's Dad noticed that going to Church had a positive impact on his daughter, and he wanted to know why. He says his visits are "very interesting." His wife is Vietnamese, so the Church has invited her to come to either the morning Mandarin Chinese worship or the afternoon Vietnamese worship. Pray that one day the whole family will be saved through God's Word and Holy Baptism.
