A man of integrity.	He was above reproach which made him open for attack; but he was so morally and ethically consistent his attackers could not find a single flaw.


Why Should We Study Prophecy?






Key Names, Words, and Concepts Daniel 1:1

Jehoiakim	Eighteenth king of the Kingdom of Judah. Made king by Pharoah-nechoh of Egypt (2 Kings 23:34-24:1; 2 Chronicles 36:4-7).	
Nebuchadnezzar	King of Babylon. Conquerer of Egypt and <i>known</i> world.	
Babylon	Also known as Chaldea.	
Besieged	Surrounded.	






How Did Jehoiakim and Jerusalem come to be surrounded by Nebuchadnezzar?

We have to understand the "Land Covenant" which God Gave to Israel.

Covenant = An agreement or promise

The Abrahamic Land Covenant



An Unconditional covenant, meaning God would not break it. But Israel did and would face judgment for disobeying God and forsaking His promise to them.


- Division of the Kingdom in BC 931.


