Why study the End Times?

- God has prophesied it since Enoch – Gen 5; Jude 14
- Many Bible books mention it, all of the last book of Revelation !!!
- Jesus' disciples wanted to know! – Mt 24
- It brings special blessings! Prevents terrible shame!

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Why study the End Times?

- It brings special blessings! Prevents terrible shame!
- It reveals God and brings Him glory!
- Belief affects behavior! It inspires responses
- We need Hope! There will be justice!

Is there anything God cannot do?

- God's Omnipotence! He is able.
- Can God make a rock too big for Himself to pick up?
- If God is so powerful, why does He allow so much evil?
- Our Hermeneutic – method of interpretation
 - Literally, historically, grammatically, and contextually
 - Metaphorically, symbolically, figuratively, spiritually
- God's immutability is at stake! Beware!

Recommended Hermeneutical Philosophy



Literal-Historical-Grammatical Method

The aim of the historical-grammatical method is to discover the meaning of the passage as the original author would have intended and what the original hearers would have understood.

TIME IS SHORT

Hermeneutical keys

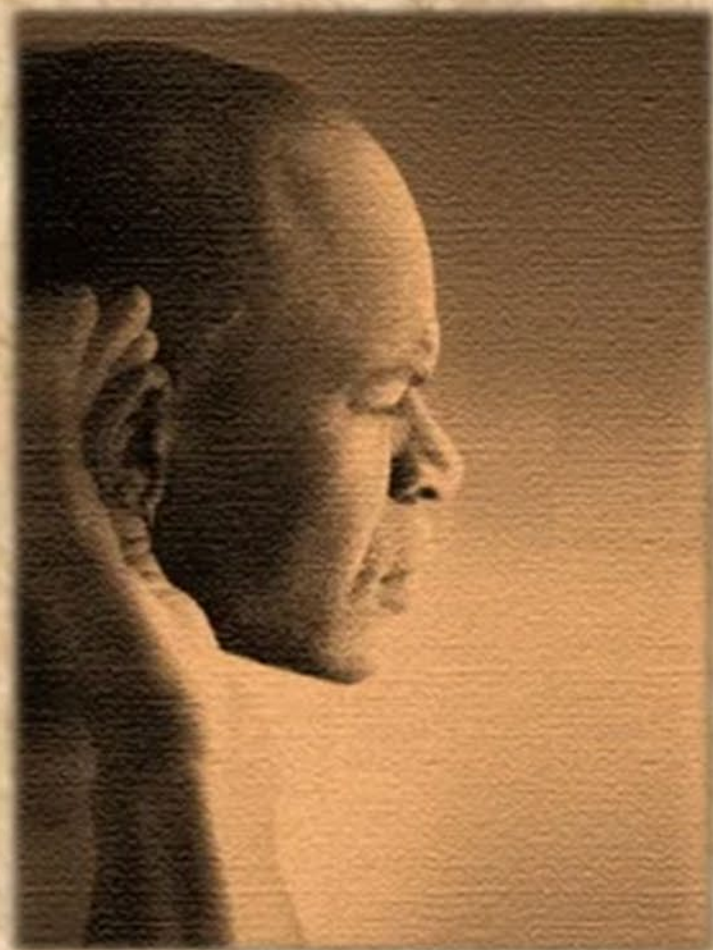
- Active listening, regardless of how unwelcome it is
- Awareness of my own anxious ears, presuppositions
 - My indoctrinated upbringing
 - My intense desires; “escape” and / or popular acceptance
 - Missing the Substantive for the Sensational
- When the plain sense of Scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense, it leads to nonsense.

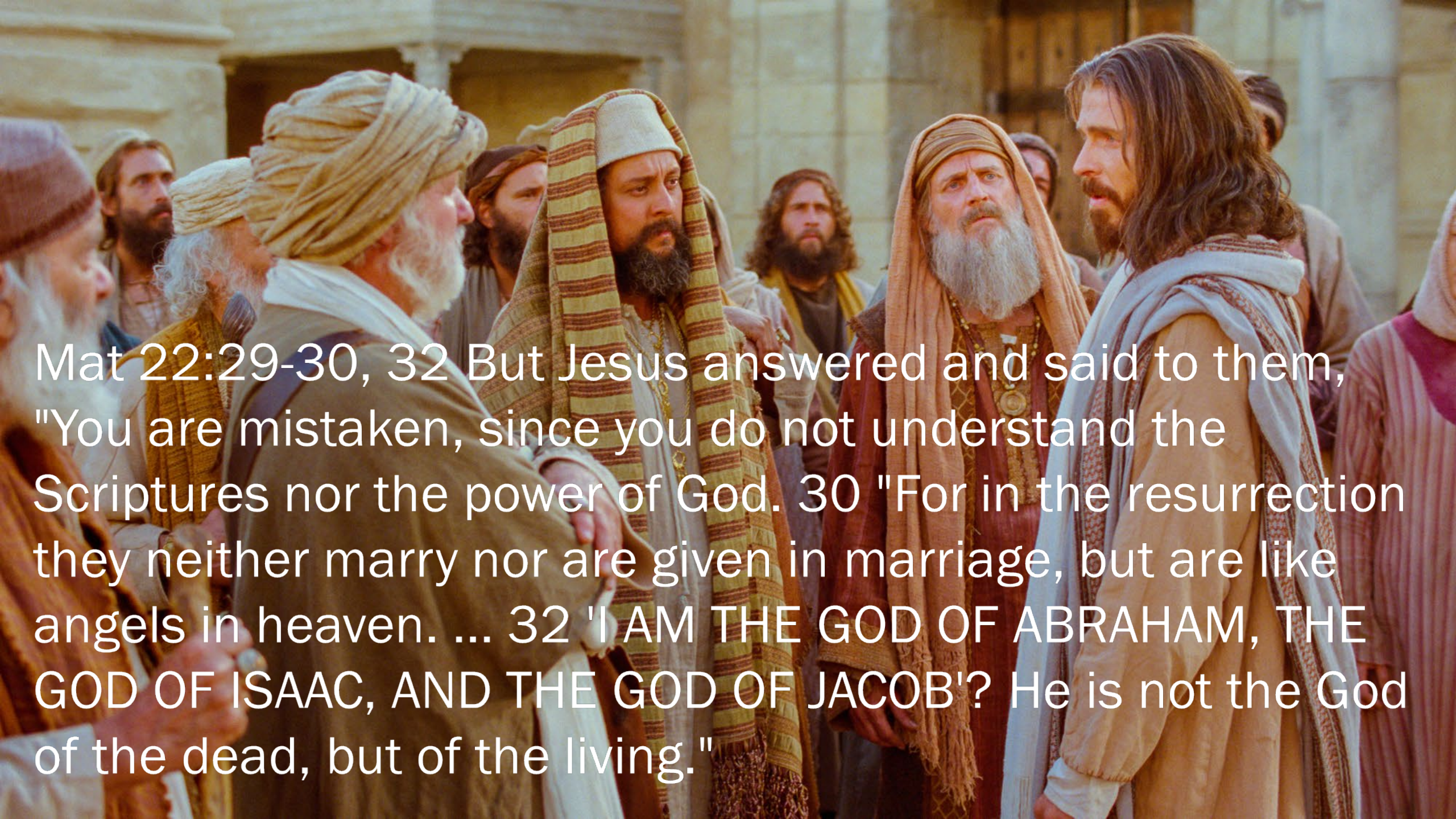
A COMMAND TO HEAR

“He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.” (Revelation 2:7)

This phrase is repeated each time in Christ's address to the seven churches of Revelation. In the gospels (it is never used in John), it is always used to highlight radical truths, great principles, and promises.

Note that Jesus says it is the Spirit speaking to the churches, even though He is the actual one talking: “All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness”
(2 Timothy 3:16)





Mat 22:29-30, 32 But Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, since you do not understand the Scriptures nor the power of God. 30 "For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. ... 32 'I AM THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB'? He is not the God of the dead, but of the living."

Too symbolic, metaphorical, “spiritualized”

- The Bible isn't infallible but contains God's words
- Maybe God used Evolution to create us?
- Man is basically good
- Jesus couldn't have been born of a Virgin
- Jesus rose from the dead in our hearts, symbolically

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Too symbolic, metaphorical, “spiritualized”

- Hell in the Bible is just an illustration / parable / lesson
- Liberalism / progressivism doesn't like a Literal Bible

The Law and the Promise

¹⁵ To give a human example, brothers:⁹ even with a man-made covenant, no one annuls it or adds to it once it has been ratified. ¹⁶ Now the promises were made **to Abraham and to his offspring.** It does not say, "And to offsprings," **referring to many, but referring to one,** "And to **your offspring,**" **who is Christ.** ¹⁷ This is what I mean: the law, which came 430 years afterward, does not annul a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to make the promise void. ¹⁸ For if the inheritance comes by the law, it no longer comes by promise; but God gave it to Abraham by a promise.

¹⁹ Why then the law? It was added because of transgressions, until the offspring should come to whom the promise had been made, and it was put in place through angels by an

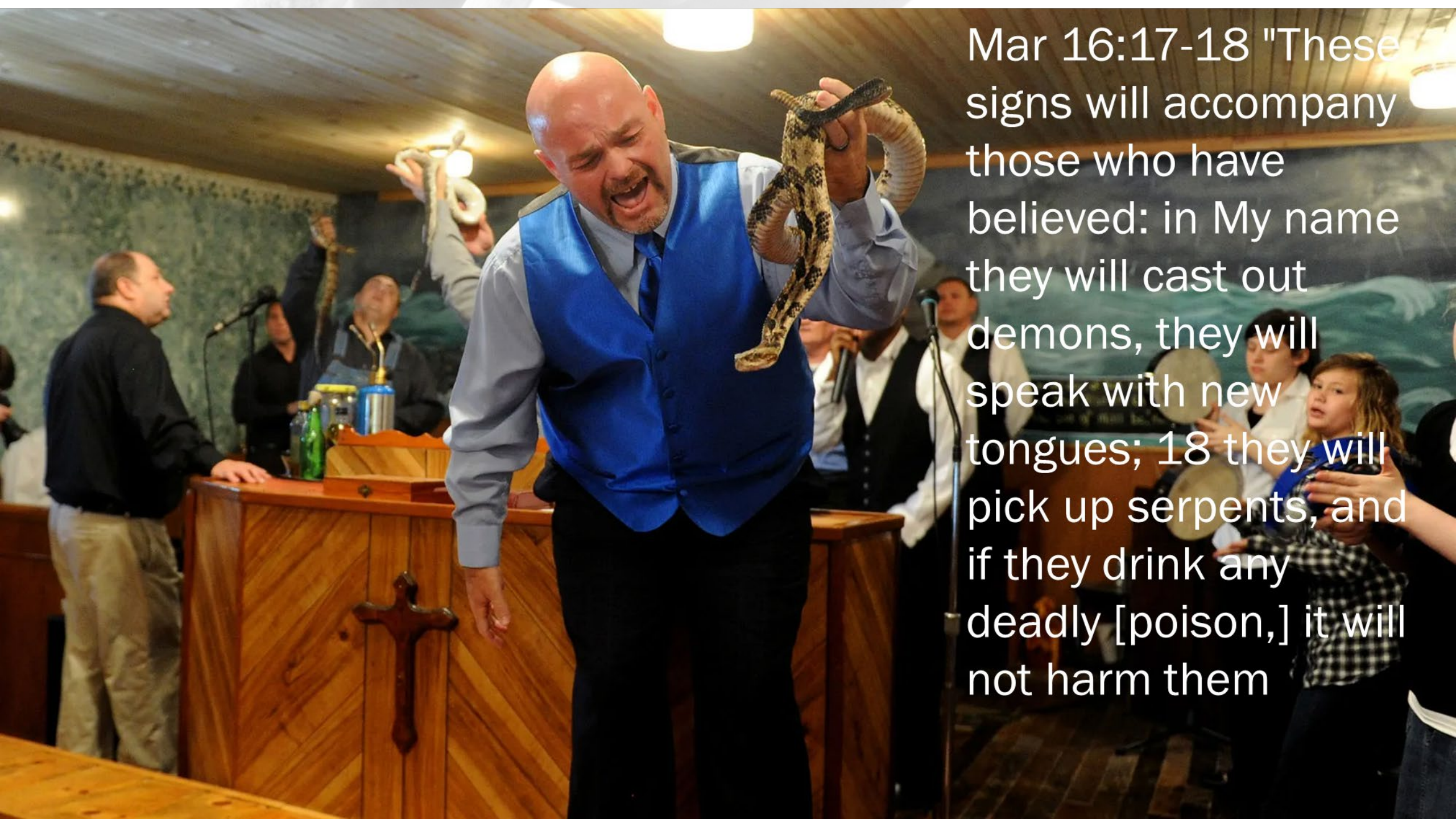
Too Literal?!

- Jhn 6:54 – “The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day”
- Jhn 6:63 – “It is the Spirit who give life; the flesh provides no benefit; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit, and are life.”

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Too Literal?!

- Rev 2:20 – You tolerate the woman Jezebel (2 Ki 9)
- Rev 3:16 – ‘So because you are lukewarm . . . I will vomit you out of My mouth.’ (does God vomit? Mouth?)
- Rev 9 – Locusts, demons or Military equipment?

V25: DECREE TO RESTORE JERUSALEM

March 5th, 444 B.C.

King Artaxerxes sets a time to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem
Nehemiah 2:1-6

7 weeks = 49 years = 395 B.C
Jerusalem restoration completed



7 + 62 = 69 Weeks
483 years = 173,880 days



V26: JERUSALEM DESTROYED

August 6th, 70 A.D.

Roman soldiers destroy Jerusalem and the Temple, by orders of Titus

Jews are dispersed across the world for almost 2000 years, until 1948, as millions of Jews return back to the Promised Land
Isaiah 66, Ezekiel 36-37

V26: CHURCH AGE

April 5th, 33 A.D. - ???

Since the Resurrection of Jesus, people of every tribe, tongue and nation have received salvation by Grace through Faith in the present age of the Church

One day soon, Christ will rapture His church that we might be with Him eternally

March 30th, 33 A.D.

5 days later He is crucified, "Cut-off" for redemption of sins
Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, John 19



V27: TRIBULATION PERIOD

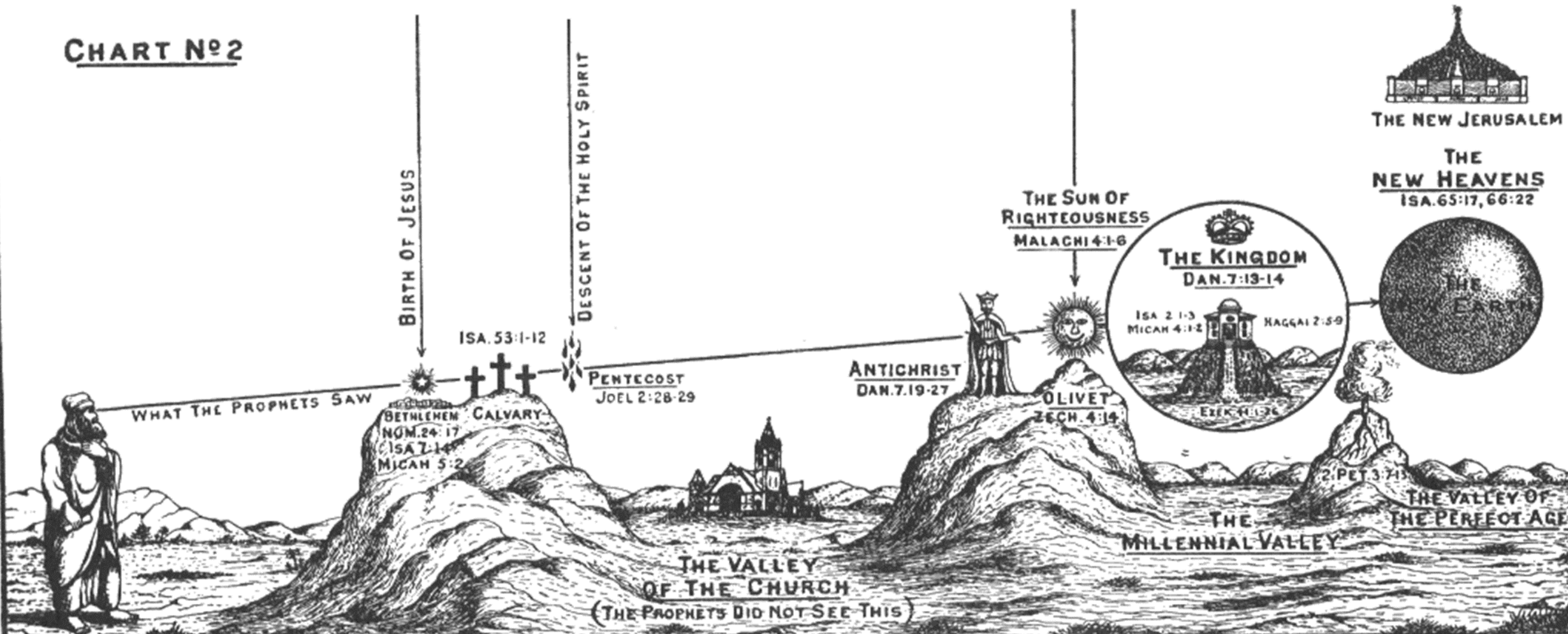
Beginning on the day that the antichrist confirms a treaty with Israel, God will pour out His wrath upon the world for 7 years in judgement and final warning to the lost
