



- We need Hope! There will be justice!




For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

Is there anything God cannot do?

- God's Omnipotence! He is able.
 - Can God make a rock too big for Himself to pick up?
 - If God is so powerful, why does He allow so much evil?
- Our Hermeneutic method of interpretation
 - Literally, historically, grammatically, and contextually
 - Metaphorically, symbolically, figuratively, spiritually
- God's immutability is at stake! Beware!

Recommended Hermeneutical Philosophy



Literal-Historical-Grammatical Method

The aim of the historical-grammatical method is to discover the meaning of the passage as the original author would have intended and what the original hearers would have understood.



Hermeneutical keys


- Active listening, regardless of how unwelcome it is
- Awareness of my own anxious ears, presuppositions
 - My indoctrinated upbringing
 - My intense desires; "escape" and / or popular acceptance
 - Missing the Substantive for the Sensational
- When the plain sense of Scripture makes common sense, seek no other sense, it leads to nonsense.


A COMMAND TO HEAR

"He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." (Revelation 2:7)

This phrase is repeated each time in Christ's address to the seven churches of Revelation. In the gospels (it is never used in John), it is always used to highlight radical truths, great principles, and promises.

Note that Jesus says it is the Spirit speaking to the churches, even though He is the actual one talking: "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness" (2 Timothy 3:16)





Too symbolic, metaphorical, "spiritualized"



The Law and the Promise

15 To give a human example, brothers:9 even with a man-made covenant, no one annuls it or adds to it once it has been ratified. 16 Now 16 promises were made to Abraham ar offspring. It does not say, "And to offspring referring to many, but referring to one, "And your offspring," who is Christ. 17 This is what mean: the law, which came 430 years afterward does not annul a covenant previously ratified by God, so as to make the promise void. 18 For if the inheritance comes by the law, it no longer comes by promise; but God gave it to Abraham by a promise.



V25: DECREE TO RESTORE JERUSALEM

March 5th, 444 B.C.

King Artaxerxes sets a time to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem Nehemiah 2:1-6

7 weeks = 49 years = 395 B.C Jerusalem restoration completed

> 7 +62 =69 Weeks 483 years = 173,880 days





V26: JERUSALEM DESTROYED

August 6th, 70 A.D.

Roman soldiers destroy Jerusalem and the Temple, by orders of Titus

Jews are dispersed across the world for almost 2000 years, until 1948, as millions of Jews return back to the Promised Land Isaiah 66, Ezekiel 36-37

V26: CHURCH AGE

April 5th, 33 A.D. - ???

Since the Resurrection of Jesus, people of every tribe, tongue and nation have received salvation by Grace through Faith in the present age of the Church

5 days later He is crucified, "Cut-off" for redemption of sins Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, John 19






V27: TRIBULATION PERIOD
