Rev. Adam and Christine Lehman (Hannah, Noah, Abigail, Jonah) are career missionaries serving in Puerto Rico. (Christ Lutheran supports them this year.) Rev. Lehman is focusing on outreach and connecting with the neighbors. He's working tirelessly to open the Mercy House in Ponce. The pastors are routinely walking to meet the neighbors and business owners. On Wednesday to Friday the routine is to get office work done in the morning, leave the church around 10:00 am and walk for an hour with Rev. Neuendorf. They meet neighbors, offer to pray for any needs they may have, and invite them to visit the church. At 11:00 am he's in the sanctuary for a Morning Prayer service for members and visitors. The church is open until 6:00 pm. Members can come and participate in activities and talk to pastors and deaconesses. 5:30 pm is a prayer service. **Pray that the Lord continues to bless this mission and that the Holy Spirit continues to work to bring more members to His church!**
