We will have several class teachers with the following coordinators: John Terrill in the Auditorium, Mike Dacus in the Family Center, and Taylor Holt in Room 109. We have tried to mix up the attendance in each class so they represent different generations together and give you an opportunity to meet new people, but the important thing is for you to be in class and participate.

I hope you will take advantage of what we are trying to do on **Wednesday nights** this summer. Each week of the month we take a different approach to help our church members get to know one another and be involved in the ministries of the Graham Street Church of Christ.

On the first Wednesday of the month we do intergenerational service, which includes work on remodeling our building, prison ministry Bible correspondence courses (New Life Behavior material), Basic Needs Ministry, sending cards to shut-ins and others needing encouragement, making casseroles, and other service projects.

On the second Wednesday night of the month we participate in intergenerational worship. This week we went to Foster Home and had a meal together followed by worship with the residents of Foster Home and another visiting church. In the next months this summer we may go to other sites or worship in the Family Center with the intention to worship together with songs and devotional thoughts that will involve all ages in worship.
