A Note About Weather

A Note About Health

Children and volunteers should not attend Awana if they have any of the following symptoms:


- Fever within the last 24 hours
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- Severely runny nose or nasty cough (these increase the chances of spreading germs to others, especially among children who lack strict hygiene habits)
- Any rash that is suspected to be contagious
- Suspected or confirmed case of head lice

Clubber Check-in

Cubbies: Please walk your cubbies to the cubby room down stairs. We request that you sign them in and make note of who will be picking them up.

Sparks/T&T/Trek: Please check-in your Sparky, TNT, and Trek clubbers at the welcome center which is right inside our foyer. There will be a designated leader present to greet you and direct your clubbers to their leaders.

Cubbies: Please pick up your cubbies from the cubby room down stairs. We request that you sign them out so that we have a record as to whom they were released to. All persons must exit through the Main Doors of the Church Building.

Sparks/T&T/Trek: Please check-out your Sparky, TNT, and Trek clubbers at the welcome center as well. There will be a designated leader present to take note of who is picking up each clubber and connect you with your child(ren).

HANDBOOK PROCEDURES

All Clubs Except Sparks work through their books at the same pace. Please refer to each clubs handbook schedule to know what should be prepared by your child each week. Verses should be memorized (mimicking is not memorizing) and children should stay on schedule, making up missed verses as they are able.

Sparky clubbers work through their books at their own pace. They should make an effort to complete 1-2 sections a week in order to finish their handbook by the end of the AWANA year.



Verse Completion Requirements

- 1. The verse(s) of each section must be recited with only 2 helps or less. This means two helps PER SECTION, not per verse if the section contains more than one verse.
- 2. Each section must be recited in one sitting, meaning they may not say half, look at it, and then finish.
- 3. The sections in the book must be completed in order. They may not skip around in the book. Exceptions include "Bring a Friend", which may be completed at any time during the year; and other activities that must be completed at home may be skipped for a week or two, but should be completed as soon as possible.

We encourage each clubber to attempt to finish one book each year. However, we recognize that it is more important for clubbers to go at a pace that allows them to truly hide God's Word in their hearts. We make every effort to acknowledge each child's accomplishments.

A Note to Parents/Guardians

As we embark on this journey together, please keep in mind that "our goal is to reach boys and girls with the Gospel of Christ and train them to serve Him." That said it is important that we work together to help our clubbers along the way.

From our leaders, you can expect willing hearts, listening ears, and words of encouragement. What we need most from you is to regularly work with your child(ren) on verse memorization. It really makes a difference on club night if a child has been practicing their Bible verses. Not only does it give them something to be excited about, but most importantly, it imprints the Word of God on their heart!

Additionally, if we are to work together to help lay a foundation of faith in God and a strong Biblical understanding in these children, we need you to assist your children in keeping track of their AWANA belongings so that they have them ready for club on Wednesday evenings. AWANA book bags are optional, but available for purchase if you find it would be helpful for your child.

Finally, we encourage AWANA families not to substitute club nights for regular church attendance. We invite you to join us on Sunday mornings for our worship service and message. The service runs from 9:30-11 and Sunday school classes follow from 11:15-12.

Expectations For Clubbers

- Clubbers should not be left unattended.
 Unescorted children will not be permitted to leave the building.
- Rowdy and/or disrespectful behavior of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Care and respect should be shown for church property.
- Running is only allowed during Game Time.
- Clubbers who choose to make poor choices will first, receive a warning. If undesirable behavior continues, they will be asked to shadow a leader. If a 3rd offense is made, their parent will be called to pick them up from AWANA early.
- Game Time is a privilege and may be revoked for a night for children who cannot
