

## Staying Faithful to Jesus

2 Corinthians 11:1-15 June 12, 2022

<u>The Big Idea</u>: We can stay faithful to Jesus by clinging to the Gospel (filling our minds and hearts with Truth) and by recognizing and actively resisting false teaching.

## 2 Corinthians 11:1-15 (ESV)

1 I wish you would bear with me in a little foolishness. Do bear with me! <sup>2</sup> For I feel a divine jealousy for you, since I betrothed you to one husband, to present you as a pure virgin to Christ. <sup>3</sup> But *I am afraid that as the serpent deceived Eve* by his cunning, your thoughts will be led astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ. <sup>4</sup> For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus than the one we proclaimed, or if you receive a different spirit from the one you received, or if you accept a different gospel from the one you accepted, you put up with it readily enough. <sup>5</sup> Indeed, I consider that I am not in the least inferior to these super-apostles. <sup>6</sup> Even if I am unskilled in speaking, I am not so in knowledge; indeed, in every way we have made this plain to you in all things.

<sup>7</sup> Or did I commit a sin in humbling myself so that you might be exalted, because I preached God's gospel to you free of charge? <sup>8</sup> I robbed other churches by accepting support from them in order to serve you. <sup>9</sup> And when I was with you and was in need, I did not burden anyone, for the brothers who came from Macedonia supplied my need. So I refrained and will refrain from burdening you in any way. <sup>10</sup> As the truth of Christ is in me, this boasting of mine will not be silenced in the regions of Achaia. <sup>11</sup> And why? Because I do not love you? God knows I do!

<sup>12</sup> And what I am doing I will continue to do, in order to undermine the claim of those who would like to claim that in their boasted mission they work on the same terms as we do. <sup>13</sup> For such men are *false apostles*, *deceitful workmen*, *disguising* themselves as apostles of Christ. <sup>14</sup> And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. <sup>15</sup> So it is no surprise if his servants, also, disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. *Their end will correspond to their deeds*.

## <u>Eternal Truths We Must Know and Live in Order to Stay</u> Faithful

- 1. From the beginning, Satan's first choice of a weapon in spiritual warfare has been deception. [Genesis 3:1-5]
- 2. Faithfulness to Jesus is largely a product of our thoughts (mind) -- knowing and being focused on spiritual truth.
- 3. To recognize false and misleading teaching it is imperative that we know what the Bible teaches about Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and the Gospel. [v. 4]
  - False teachers will deviate from teaching what
    Scripture declares about the Son of God.
  - False teachers will not present orthodox teaching about our Triune God (One God who is eternally Father, Son, and Spirit).
  - False Teachers will reject salvation by grace through faith, presenting a "gospel" that is Jesus plus something else.
- 4. It is wonderful to have the combination of Biblical knowledge delivered by skillful speakers, but truth will always be more important than style. [v. 6]
- 5. False teachers are masters of deceit and disguise characteristics of Satan himself. Faithful servants are committed to the truth of Scripture, the true Gospel of Jesus, and the welfare of God's people the Church. The Lord will judge, but we must learn to discern! [vv. 12-15]

## Lord Jesus,

we confess you as our Savior and Lord. Help us to love you with our minds and our whole hearts. Give us a love for Your Word that drives us to know you and follow you in all things. Give us grace to remain faithful to You.
