DB's Dabblings: "Why "3 Big Questions"?

You may be wondering what our "3 Big Questions" Bible Classes has to do with our Family Youth Minister. I am glad you asked! There are 3 big answers I can think of I can give you to help you see how this study helps our Youth and Family Ministry and the person we hire in the future to lead the ministry:

- 1) The 3 Big Questions comes from the research of the Fuller Youth Institute (Fuller Theological Seminary) and the book by Kara Powell and Brad M. Griffin that came out of it, **3 Big Questions**, **Questions That Change Every Teenager**. Their research of teens all over the United States indicates that these are the most often mentioned questions being asked by teens. Churches need to understand why teens are asking these questions and help them answer them from a spiritual perspective.
- 2) We also need to understand that our children are growing into these questions, and we need to develop a children's ministry that will help children and their parents deal with these questions as they mature. So, our Children's Ministry needs to develop an approach that will provide resources to help the whole family deal with these important questions.
- 3) We don't outgrow these 3 Big Question. You will always be dealing with these 3 important questions, and we all need to help one another in the church deal with them from perspectives that represent all generations young and old. The wisdom of these cross-generational perspectives will help us all grow spiritually and create a family church environment. Helping each other in practical ways answer these questions with the help of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit may save us all from making some bad choices in life. We could all benefit from the words of Proverbs 1:2-7 (NRSV).

For learning about wisdom and instruction, for understanding words of insight, for gaining instruction in wise dealing, righteousness, justice, and equity; to teach shrewdness to the simple, knowledge and prudence to the young—let the wise also hear and gain in learning, and the discerning acquire skill, to understand a proverb and a figure, the words of the wise and their riddles. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.


