New AWARE Food Bank Partnership

Many are aware of the short-term partnership of our church with the AWARE Food Bank. They began using our east wing in May as their TEMPORARY food distribution center. Their building was destroyed by fire last August and recently needed to move to another temporary location while their current building is rebuilt. They are using most of the east wing of our building, which now has a separate entrance with the doors into the



rest of the church securely locked. As part of their usage agreement, they are giving our church \$4,000/month (plus utilities). All modifications to our facility (a new sidewalk in the back plus electrical upgrades) were done at the expense of the food bank. They will be in our facility for at least the next 12 months.

They distribute food to the community four days a week plus two afternoons a month:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 9:00AM to 12:00PM

1st and 3rd Tuesday of the Month 3:30-6:00PM

The food bank is a great place to put love into action and serve our community. See Pastor Steve about how you can be the hands and feet of Jesus right in our own building.
