DB's Dabblings: "A Simple Sign – Don't Give Up" (Philippians 1:15-18)

I saw a sign in someone's yard, a simple sign, white with black letters that read: "Don't give up!" I thought, "Isn't that a message we all need right now?" In a somewhat "post-covid" time following one of the craziest times of our history, and yet COVID still sits as one of the apocalyptic horsemen ready to ride in again. "Don't give up!"

In a time when Russia is bombing Ukraine and millions have fled their homeland, probably to never return home, and millions more are trapped inside as their food and ammunition to defend themselves runs out. "Don't give up!"

Americans and fellow NATO countries have made great sacrifices to support the Ukrainian people and their right to be free. We bear the burden caused by this support in higher gas prices and inflation of everything! "Don't give up!"

A time when our streets are too often filled with crime, drugs, and violence. Violence that spills over into our schools where young children are killed in mass shootings by eighteen-year-olds. We still say, "Don't give up!"

A time when our country is divided over life and death, freedom and slavery, and politics, long since the issues of the Civil War. When our trust in our government is at its lowest, and many have lost faith that our democracy is still the best form of government in the world and that it will last. "Don't give up!"

Then someone burst my enthusiasm for that simple sign that filled my heart with such optimism and enthusiasm by telling me that they thought I misunderstood its intent. It is not, they told me, a bold statement of courage to all who are disheartened by our shared hard times to keep going in faith for in the end truth and love will win. "No," he said, "that sign is to a small group of people that in spite of all the evidence to the contrary, believe that the election was rigged and the former president will be reinstated! So, 'Don't Give Up the Fight'"

I wanted to cry and scream, "You have got to be kidding me!" And I thought, "Please, give up that fight!" Fight for the cause of what's good, and right, and truthful. Fight for children who need something to eat and a safe place to sleep. Fight for the freedom to vote, and the peaceful transition of government, whether the majority voted like you, or not. Fight for justice and honor, integrity and truth. Don't fight for your way, but your right to have a say, in peace and respect for other views. It broke my heart to think that such a good sign could mean such a different thing to someone else, but then I cheered up thinking, "Maybe most people take it to mean what I did!" "Don't give up!"


