Greetings in the lovely name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We pray this finds you all faithful in the service of our great God and Saviour!! These last 2 months have been exciting as we continue to labor here in the Western Highlands of Papua New Guinea.

The bible school in Nebilyer, Nebilyer Baptist Bible School, is doing very well, and the students are doing very well in their studies and assignments. In our preaching class, we have been giving opportunities to the Bible school students to put into practice what we have been studying. During class time, they have been preaching (some of them for the first time), the various styles of sermons we have been going through in class, and many of them have been doing a wonderful job. Also, during our weekly outreach, the students have been getting chances to preach publicly in various markets and open areas around the Western Highlands.

One of the areas where we have recently started doing outreach is actually about 90 minutes north in another district(Mul-Baiyer). The Baiyer valley has about 60,000 people, and no bible believing church in it. Another pastor, Peter Dom, has been walking about 6 hours every other Sunday through the mountains to try to get a church started in this area. So far, there are about 10 people faithfully coming to this small church plant, but no full-time pastor. We have decided to take the students from the Bible school up to this area once a month to assist with outreach and to try to help establish this work in Tiki. **Please pray that God will bless these efforts and allow a permanent work to be established in the Baiyer Valley.**

Also, the Bible classes here in town on Tuesday nights are continuing to go very well. Approximately 90 people are continuing to come faithfully to these classes, many of them from hours away, and God is continuing to bless. We are anticipating and preparing to see this work develop into a full time Bible Institute sometime around the beginning of next year, but please continue to pray that this work will go forward in the right way, and in the Lord's timing.

Next month(August), I have been asked to teach a series of lessons on baptism for pastor Sam Luru and Pilgrim's Baptist Church in Nebilyer. Pastor Sam Luru is one of the pastors who is teaching in our Nebilyer Bible School, and he is a tremendous blessing. He has had quite a few folks recently get saved in his church, and before he baptizes them, he would like to hold this meeting to ensure everyone has a proper understanding of this important doctrine.

Lastly, election season is on us here in Papua New Guinea, and with this comes the expected turmoil associated with a third world country during this time. Random fights, roadblocks, and other problems are becoming more and more common, so we would greatly appreciate your prayers for safety during this time.
