- **How to become a member of CFB - per the constitution**
Persons may be received into membership by any one of four methods, as appropriate, upon recommendation of the Pastor, the Diaconate, and the vote of the church.
 1. By Baptism: Any person professing faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, giving evidence of a change of heart and a firm commitment to follow the example set by Christ, may be received into the church upon baptism by immersion.
 2. By Letter: By letter of transfer or recommendation from another church of like faith and order.
 3. By Christian Experience: Any believer, having been previously baptized, may be received upon a satisfactory statement of Christian faith and experience.
 4. By Exception: Persons physically or mentally unable to be immersed may be received by verbal confession of faith before the congregation. The Diaconate May wish to consider an alternate mode of baptism in such an instance.Anyone interested in joining the church should contact the church office. A September date is set for baptism. There will be a 4 part discipleship class that is open to youth and adults. Please contact Claudia Little (585-307-8821) or call the church office (585-968-1531) if you have questions or need more information.
- **Covid supplies!** Cuba First Baptist has a supply of cloth masks (adult & youth), sanitizer and Covid home tests. If you have a need for any of these, please call the church office or stop into the office after worship on Sunday. These items were secured through Allegany County Dept. of Health and are free to anyone in need of them.
