Phase 1 of A/C work is move 3 thermos, move return, move ducting around for \$2500.00. Gayle made the motion, Kay 2nd and all in favor. Tony didn't recommend leaving units on or off, so we are leaving at 80.

Gene made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Kay, none opposed. Closing prayer was given by Pastor Jack Thomas, meeting was adjourned at 2:07 pm.
