## **Notebook Standard**

In utilizing the Principle Approach at EGCA, we ask that students be equipped with the foundation tool of teaching and learning – the notebook. This is defined as **a hard cover**, 3-ring binder, of a durable quality for the daily use, wear, and tear. These binders are readily available at Staples, Walmart, Target, or any other supplies store in a variety of colors, sizes, and prices. It is recommended that you choose a binder with a spine window for labeling and/or binders of various colors.

Students use these notebooks to maintain a record of their education through the subject organization of regular note taking, assignments, essays, tests, and the proper securing of class handouts. Additional items needed for your child's grade level are listed below.
