Yesterday was a historical event in the Bible College/School building project. Two years, two months and nine days had passed since the groundbreaking ceremony, May 5, 2020. At that time, it was just a vision and a drawing. As of yesterday, the last section of concrete roof was poured to complete the structure of the first two stories. We thank God, and all of you who were used of God to participate in making this event happen in a much shorter time than we had ever dreamed possible.



Of course, there is still a great deal more to be accomplished with the plastering, painting, tile flooring, electrical installation, lighting, fans, bathrooms, demolition of the remaining old buildinas. landscaping, parking lots. sidewalks, playground, etc., etc. Then, there is still a third story in the plan. But again, it was a very important day and I am very grateful to all who helped.

June 26 was the 35th

anniversary of the "mother church" in Tuxtla Gutiérrez. Taking that number, we enlisted 35 men and 35 women to form teams of three or four members with the goal of each team inviting 35 people to the special two hour service. The work paid off and there were 752 people in the a.m. service, the largest anniversary service ever for this church. Between the a.m. and p.m. services

there were 124 first-time visitors and 14 people who trusted Christ as Savior. What a blessed time it was!
