A team of athletes is not only a group of individuals with a common focus on winning games, not only with particular talents, particular skills, but a shared understanding of their team's particular philosophy, strategies and plays. In the same way, it is important that those leading others as **disciple-makers** in a local congregation not only be those who know Christ and who use their particular and varied skills to bring a common message, but also share in the foundational objectives of their congregation.

As a congregation, we want to bring a **clear and unified message** - the Good News of Salvation and New Life in **Jesus Christ** alone, by **Grace** alone through **Faith** alone as given in the **Word** alone. It is important that the **disciple-making team** be 'on the same page' when bringing this message to those we instruct. The lack of a common message will at best be confusing to our hearers and at worst, result in them rejecting the Gospel. For this reason we want to cultivate a common Biblical understanding regarding important questions such as:

- How God reveals Himself to people
- The Central Message of the Word of God
- The Trustworthiness of the Word of God (Holy Scripture)
- How the Word of God works to bring about salvation
- How the Word of God works in encouraging spiritual life
- How to properly interpret the Word of God
