If you are visiting with us today, please be sure to introduce yourself to Pastor Fields and Pastor Mongoven Easton and sign our guest book as you leave.

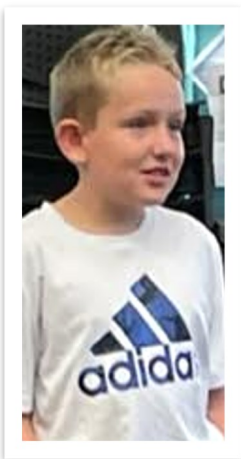

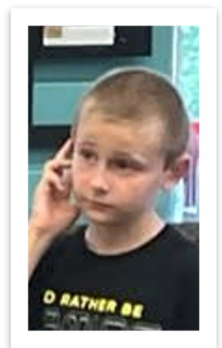

Please place them directly in the outdoor library

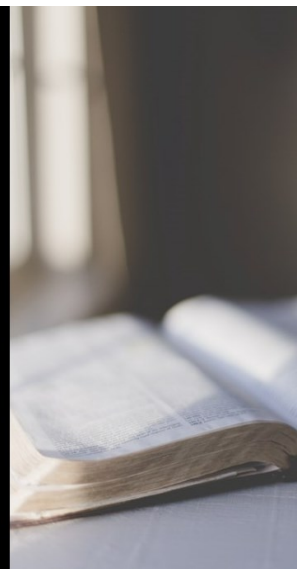
