# FRUIT THAT IS NEVER OUT OF SEASON "Gentleness is Power Under Control" Philippians 4:5

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. There is no law against these things! (Galatians 5:22-23 NLT).

Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near (Philippians 4:5 NIV).

Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls" (Matthew 11:28-29 NLT).

Two steps to become a	biblically meek or gentle person:
1. Only	can do it for you.

2. It is a conscious decision to	o to the
Lordship of Jesus Christ.

# Five elements of gentle people (POWER):

We don't need to change our personalities and become a different kind of person. Rather, we simply need to put our personality under God's control.

# O\_\_\_\_\_\_ under God's control.

Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too. You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had (Philippians 2:4-5 NLT).

## Gentle people are \_\_\_\_\_\_, not quarrelsome.

... learn to put aside your own desires so that you will become patient and godly, gladly letting God have his way with you. This will make possible the next step, which is for you to enjoy other people and to like them, and finally you will grow to love them deeply. The more you go on in this way, the more you will grow strong spiritually and become fruitful and useful to our Lord Jesus Christ (2 Peter 1:6-8 TLB).

## W under God's control.

Watch the way you talk. Let nothing foul or dirty come out of your mouth. Say only what helps, each word a gift (Ephesians 4:29, MSG).

And the tongue is a flame of fire. It is full of wickedness, and poisons every part of the body ... Men have trained, or can train, every kind of animal or bird that lives and every kind of reptile and fish, but no human being can tame the tongue. It is always ready to pour out its deadly poison (James 3:6-8 TLB).

## under God's control.

Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love (Ephesians 4:2 NLT).
