Pastoral Call Committee

Per standard practice the District office/President is being asked to identify potential candidates.

- praying over the process, especially that God brings the pastor we need to fill this upcoming vacancy
- providing names of any LCMS pastors you are familiar with who in your opinion could be a viable candidate
- asking for the Holy Spirit's guidance in this process.
