### **Pencils and Crayons from Heaven needs your help!**

Again this year Cuba First Baptist will be offering a free Back Pack of school supplies to the area youth. “Pencils and Crayons from Heaven” has been a successful mission for years and hopes to continue to serve the community. Cuba-Rushford students from pre-K thru grade 5 are invited to register for the distribution being held on August 13<sup>th</sup>. Any family that could use a little extra help as they prepare for the 2022-23 school year is encouraged to call the church office (585-968-1531) to set up a pick up appointment time. If it's after office hours, please leave a message and the call will be returned.

Students will receive a great new backpack, and the basic needs for their grade. A parent or guardian should accompany the kids for their pick up. P & C was able to assist over 80 kids in 2021. With the economy in turmoil, it is hoped to help as many, if not more.

Anyone interested in supporting the mission can do so by sending or bringing financial donations to the church office. Checks should be made payable to: Cuba First Baptist with “school supplies” in the memo line. Church address is 17 South St, Cuba, NY. 14727. The cost of a back pack this year will be about \$50. This is partially supported by a grant from the Renodin Foundation, but more help will be needed. It is said that it takes a village to raise a child, and in our uncertain economic time – it's more important than ever.
