

## What happens during Sunday Gatherings?

- Sundays Gatherings begin at 4pm EST and last about an hour.
  This is our version of a Sunday service.
- You can choose to turn your camera on or off at any time. (If you'd rather us never see you, you can leave your camera off the entire time.) You can mute yourself at any time, too.
- We start by saying hi to each other. We'd love to hear from everyone, so even if you're in preschool (or younger!), we'd love to get to know you! Parents, if you join us with your camera off, please let us know you're watching with your children or teens so we can say hello!
- When we're ready to begin, Hannah or Ms. Allison might have a special brief activity, challenge, or object lesson just for our younger kids!

- Next, Pastor Gerald leads us in a short prayer and then mutes everyone so we can listen to a sermon. Families can decide what they'd like their children to do during this time- they can listen along with us or take a break, depending on their age. (If you create something related to the passage, like a Lego building or drawing, maybe you can share it after the sermon is over!)
- When the sermon is over, Pastor Gerald unmutes everyone (though you can stay muted if you'd like) and we talk about what we learned together. No one- kids, teens, or adults- have to say anything if they'd rather not.
- Then we say a closing prayer and sign off.
