**Give us this day our daily bread...**

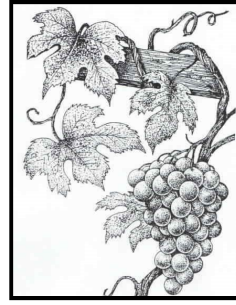
