Our hearts so easily lead us astray. We're easily drawn aside from following the Lord and pursuing Him with our whole heart. A close relationship with God is not something we "do" and check off a list, never to give attention to it again. Like any other relationship, it requires consistent intention and purpose. In truth, there will never be a point in our lives here on Earth when we will be immune to the danger of a heart that fails to love God as it should. The church at Ephesus was one of the greatest churches of the first century, vet they fell into this trap. "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love" (Revelation 2:4). If we are to love God for our entire life, we must "with purpose of heart" choose to "cleave unto the Lord."

Don't allow the temptations and pressures of life to draw you away from your love for Christ.

We live in a world filled with temptations designed specifically to draw our hearts away from God. The devil knows that, and he is happy to use anything to take God's rightful place in our hearts. Satan does not have to get us to succumb to temptation to great sin to accomplish his goal. He simply needs to get us to love something or someone else more than we love God. Because of our sinful nature, it is easy for us to be drawn away from what is most important. No one has a close, loving, intimate relationship with God accidentally.
