LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 16:10-12 "Jesse had seven of his sons pass before Samuel, but Samuel said to him, "The Lord has not chosen these." ¹¹ So he asked Jesse, "Are these all the sons you have?" "There is still **the youngest**," Jesse answered. "He is tending the sheep." Samuel said, "Send for him; we will not sit down until he arrives." ¹² So he sent for him and had him brought in. He was glowing with health and had a fine appearance and handsome features. Then the Lord said, "Rise and anoint him; this is the one."

LESSONS FOR US:

- God can use the young too.
 - Jesse had eight sons, but God chose the **youngest**, David, to lead His people as King.
 - When Goliath looked David over, he saw that he was little more than **a boy**. 1 Sam. 17:42
 - Samuel was ministering before the Lord, and he was only **a boy**. 1 Samuel 2:18
 - Josiah was **eight years old** when he became king over Judah, and he reigned thirty-one years. He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord. 2 Kings 22:1-2
 - Jesus was able to use the help of **a boy** and his five small barley loaves and two small fish to feed over five thousand people. John 6:9-13
 - Paul told Timothy not to let anyone look down on him because he was **young**. 1 Tim. 4:12
 - Let us remember that God can use young people to accomplish His will.
