# LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

**1 Samuel 17:1-53** The Story of David and Goliath. The Philistines and the Israelites set up to do battle (1-3). Goliath offers a challenge and the Israelite army is terrified (4-11). David arrives at the Israelite's camp, hears Goliath's challenge and sees the terrified reaction of the Israelite army (20-24). David's faith in God motivates him to accept Goliath's challenge (32-40). David's defeat of Goliath gives great confidence to the Israelite army and they pursue and slaughter the Philistines (41-53).

# **LESSONS FOR US:**

- Be a problem solver and inspire others.
  - David saw Goliath was presenting a problem for the Israelite army, he knew that God had rescued him from a bear and a lion in the past and was confident that God would rescue him from Goliath, so he accepted Goliath's challenge and defeated him. David was a problem solver. His faith inspired others to put their faith in God.
  - God calls us to be problem solvers. Jesus said in Matthew 5:23-24 "Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift."
