## Mark 11:1-11 CBS

When they approached Jerusalem, at Bethphage and Bethany near the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples <sup>2</sup> and told them, "Go into the village ahead of you. As soon as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it. <sup>3</sup> If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here right away.'"

<sup>4</sup> So they went and found a colt outside in the street, tied by a door. They untied it, <sup>5</sup> and some of those standing there said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" <sup>6</sup> They answered them just as Jesus had said; so they let them go.

<sup>7</sup> They brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes on it, and he sat on it. <sup>8</sup> Many people spread their clothes on the road, and others spread leafy branches cut from the fields. <sup>9</sup> Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted:

Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! <sup>10</sup> Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! Hosanna in the highest heaven!

<sup>11</sup> He went into Jerusalem and into the temple. After looking around at everything, since it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the Twelve.

- 1. Do you have any stories about cultural miscommunications you can share with the group?
- 2. Have you ever had God answer a prayer you *shouldn't* have been praying? How did you learn through that experience?
- 3. In what ways do you find yourself shifting your focus from King Jesus to an earthly kingdom?
- 4. When God's plan was different than the crowd's expectations, the celebration of the king turned into a call for Jesus' death. How have you responded when God's plan looks different from yours? How does the Bible call us to respond?
