

We had great ministry and fellowship opportunities in July! 4th of July celebration, corn ministry and all church lunch.


























The center pieces for the lunch were the Polish Flag, American Flag and the Ukrainian Flower.




School starts back for Salisbury on August 23rd. Pray for all of the staff, students and school board. We are blessed with a great school!
